Welcome New and Current Members!

We want to take this time to welcome you to our club and let you know some of the benefits of being a member. Our club is totally run by volunteers.



Member benefits include voting for board members: individual memberships have one vote, and family memberships have two votes. Members also receive first chance for enrolling in class, within a timely manner, and receive a \$10 discount for classes.

The club has three meetings a year, April, August, and November. These will be scheduled and announced on our Facebook page, website, and an email will be sent to the members. The November meeting is where officers are voted for. Any member can be nominated for a position on the board. Nominations are taken approximately in Sept-Oct prior to the vote. Voting is done electronically to make it easier for our members.

Because our club is run entirely by members, we need your help to be successful. There are several ways you can volunteer and get involved in the club.

After you have completed a few classes, please consider being a helper/teacher. We can line you up with an experienced instructor who has been doing it for a while. Instructors earn Agility Bucks that can be used towards future classes as well as punch cards for the Post Advanced class. Income from classes is what keeps our club going and is our main revenue source.

Another way you can help is volunteering at our annual agility trial in June. Before the trial begins, we need help loading equipment into the trailer and moving it to the trial site. Once at the site we unload the trailer and set up a 100 by 100-foot ring for the dogs to run in. During the trial we have several volunteer positions that need to be filled: course builders, timers, scribes, leash runners, bar setters, and scribe sheet runners. We also ask for donations of food as well as people to serve the food during the trial. After the trial, the ring must be taken down and equipment loaded back into the trailer.

Periodically the equipment and training center needs a deep cleaning.

We have a suggestion box at the center and we encourage you to voice any concerns/suggestions you may have and place them in the locked box. The board will address them to the best of our ability.
